
### 1. Welcome

Thank you for using the Jabra Elite 65e. We hope you will enjoy it!


#### Jabra Elite 65e features

- Active Noise Cancellation (ANC) to reduce disturbances
- Power battery to fuel all-day use (up to 13 hours on a 2 hour charge)
- Dual-connectivity to two Bluetooth devices, enabling you to take calls and listen to music on two devices using the same earbuds
- Up to 10 meters / 33 feet of wireless range for true mobility
- Vibrating call alert to ensure you never miss a call
- HearThrough feature: Hear the conversations around you at the touch of a button



### 3. How to wear


Jabra Elite 65e is designed to be worn around the neck

The earbuds have three microphones: one on each of the earbuds and one on the cable. For the optimal call experience, position the microphone on the cable as close to your mouth as possible, and wear both earbuds in your ears.



#### 3.1 Getting the correct fit


The earbuds are supplied with three EarGel and EarWing sizes: large, medium and small.



It is highly recommended to mix and match the different EarGel and EarWing sizes to find the best combination for your ear. The correct fit will feel tight and will seal out background noises.

# 3.2 Attaching the EarWings and EarGels

- To attach an EarWing, align the indent on the EarWing with the ridge on the earbud (as illustrated), and stretch the EarWing over the earbud. It will fit perfectly in the groove when properly attached.
- 2. Firmly press the EarGel onto the earbud, ensuring it is angled correctly (as illustrated).



#### 3.3 Using the magnetic earbuds


The earbuds are magnetic, and connect together for convenient cable and power management. When the earbuds are connected, your music will be paused or your call will be ended. Separating the earbuds will answer an incoming call. Go to section 6.1. for more information.



# 4. How to charge


To charge the earbuds, connect a USB charging cable to the USB charging port on the neckband. It is recommended to charge the earbuds using the supplied Jabra charging cable, however it is possible to charge the earbuds using your smartphone charger.

It takes approx. 2 hours to fully charge the earbuds.



Note: Always clean and dry the USB charging port before charging the earbuds. It is recommended to recharge the earbuds at least once a month.




## 5. How to connect

#### 5.1 Power on/off


**On**: Hold the **Multi-function** button for 1 second. The LED will flash green, and the neckband will vibrate

**Off**: Hold the **Multi-function** button for 3 seconds. The LED will flash red, and the neckband will vibrate.




#### 5.2 Pairing with a smartphone

 Ensure the earbuds are powered off, and then hold (3 secs) the Multi-function button until the LED flashes blue and you hear an announcement in the earbuds.



2. Wear the earbuds and follow the voice-guided pairing instructions.

#### 6.1 Calls & music



	Play/pause music	Press the <b>Multi-function</b> button, when listening to music

	Reject call	Double-press the <b>Multi-function</b> button

	Answer/end call or pause music	Detach/attach the Magnetic earbuds
	Adjust volume	Press the <b>Volume up</b> or <b>Volume down</b> button, when listening to music or on a call
<b>*</b> !\	Next track	Hold (1 sec) the <b>Volume up</b> button (smartphone only)
	Previous track	Hold (1 sec) the <b>Volume down</b> button (smartphone only)
	Battery status	Press the <b>Volume up</b> or <b>Volume down</b> button, when not listening to music or on a call
	Siri or Google Now	Press the <b>Mute/Voice</b> button, when not on a call
/ 💆	Mute/un-mute microphone	Press the <b>Mute/Voice</b> button, when on a call
/e/	Cycle between ANC and HearThrough modes	Press the <b>ANC/ HearThrough</b> button

#### 6.2 Active Noise Cancellation (ANC)

The earbuds use Active Noise Cancellation (ANC) to reduce outside disturbance, allowing you to fully focus.


Press the **ANC/HearThrough** button to cycle through the available options.



#### 6.3 HearThrough

HearThrough enables you to hear your surroundings or engage in conversations without needing to remove the earbuds.

Press the **ANC/HearThrough** button to cycle through the available options.



#### 6.4 Voice guidance

Voice guidance are announcements intended to guide you or give earbud status updates (e.g. connection and battery status).

#### How to turn voice guidance On/Off

Voice guidance is enabled by default.

Voice Guidance On: Ensure the earbuds are powered on, and then hold the Mute/Voice button for 5 seconds.



Voice Guidance Off: Ensure the earbuds are powered on, and then hold the Mute/Voice button for 5 seconds.



#### 6.5 Siri or Google Now

Phone voice commands enable you to speak to Siri or Google Now on your smartphone using your earbuds. For more information on using Siri or Google Now, please refer to your smartphone's user manual.

#### Phone voice commands



Activate Siri or Google Now (phone dependent)

Press the **Mute/Voice** button, when not on a call

Voice assistant settings can be configured using the Jabra Sound+ app.


#### 6.6 Multiple call handling

The earbuds can answer or reject calls when you are already on a call.

	Multiple call handling	
	End current call and answer incoming call	Press the <b>Multi-function</b> button
\ <u>``</u>	Put current call on hold and answer incoming call	Hold (1 secs) the <b>Multi-function</b> button
	Switch between held call and active call	Hold (1 secs) the <b>Multi-function</b> button
	Reject incoming call, when on a call	Double-tap the <b>Multi-function</b> button

#### 6.7 Vibrate alert

The earbuds will vibrate whenever they are powered on/off, connected to your smartphone or computer, or when there is an incoming call.



#### 6.8 How to reset

Resetting the earbuds clears the list of paired devices and all earbud settings.

After resetting, it is necessary to re-pair the earbuds to your smartphone.

#### Reset



Ensure the earbuds are powered on and you are not on a call. Then simultaneously hold the **Volume up** button and the **Multi-function** button for 5 seconds. You will then need to re-pair the earbuds.

The Jabra Sound+ app also enables you to:

- · Firmware update the earbuds
- Manage voice prompts
- Enable/disable vibration

#### 8.2 How to care for your earbuds

- Always store the earbuds with the power off and safely protected.
- Avoid storage at extreme temperatures
   (above 50°C/122°F or below -10°C/14°F). This
   can shorten battery life and may affect the
   earbuds.
- Regularly clean the metal mesh on each earbud to avoid them becoming blocked.
